Join a Tree Restoration Project Near You:



The Mission:

Bring a group of friends and cadets together and join forces with a local organization that is planting trees January 24 or January 25, 2026 in your area to provide more green canopy and reduce tree deserts.



The Plan:

Find Partners who are holding tree reforestation events the weekend of January 24 and 25, 2026 and join in the fun. For instance, there is a Forest Restoration in Atlanta Memorial Park, Atlanta, GA or a Mercer Arboretum Planting in Houston, TX on January 24, 2026; a "Plantapalooza" in St. Petersburg, FL on January 25, 2026; or in Los Angeles TreePeople provides tree-planting opportunities in the Los Angeles area. You can check out local reforestation organizations in the Arbor Day Foundation Partner Database.

Organize a Small Tree-Planting Event in Your Community:

The Mission:

Bring a group of friends and cadets together one morning to plant trees around your neighborhood and provide more green canopy.

The Plan:

- Find Partners who provide free trees to plant: <u>Neighborhood Forest</u> works across the United States, <u>NeighborWoods</u> in Austin, TX, the <u>New York Restoration Project</u> in New York, NY, <u>City Plants</u> in Los Angeles, CA, request a new <u>City Plants</u> program in your community, or contact <u>Tree Nation</u> to send trees to you.
- Choose the Right Tree Species: Use the <u>Audubon Society's Native Plant and Tree Tool</u>, check out the <u>USDA Plant Hardiness Zone Map</u> so that the tree is right for your climate and location, OR speak to a gardener or arborist at local Tree Nurseries, Garden Centers, or Home Improvement Stores like <u>The Home Depot</u> or <u>Lowe's</u> Garden Department.
- Make a borrow list: you will need shovels, bags or boxes for seedlings and saplings, and tarps to keep the area clean. **Avoid buying new!**
- Confirm the exact planting site(s): work with your Local Parks Departments (go to your city, town, or county's official website for your local government and search for "Parks" or "Recreation" department), your school's/college's grounds department, or your own backyard.
- MAKE SURE to call your local utility before digging in an unknown area and check soil quality before digging. For urban areas use pre-approved tree pits or raised beds AND for rural areas plant along streams or established windbreaks/ hedgerows on private or preserved land.
